4. WHIP CORD CONNECTION



The following section discusses specific components of the AIO™ Wall Mounted units. For details on each component's location, refer to the 'Components' section in the relevant installation manual.

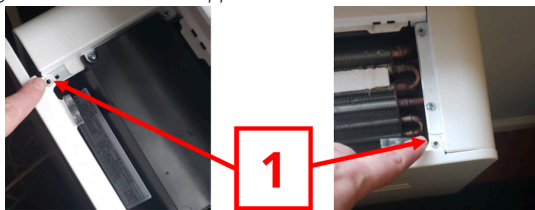

4.1 AIO™ Wall Mounted and Wall Mounted Pro Gen 1 Units

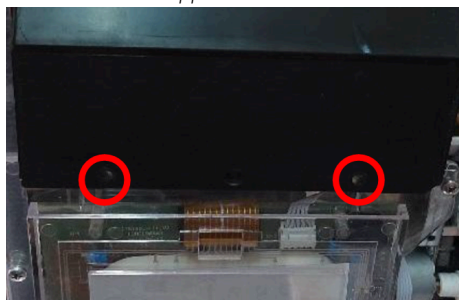
1. Remove the upper grille.
2. Remove the two (2) upper screws that fasten the front panel and remove the panel, lifting it slightly to do so.

3. Remove the two (2) upper screws that fasten the electrical part cover, and remove the cover.

Figure 2. Remove the two upper screws

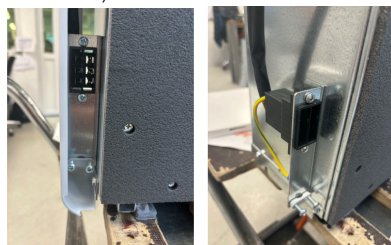


4. Disconnect the power cord by unscrewing the three (3) screws from the terminal block.
5. Connect the power cable, including the ground, checking that the power supply line has a suitable ground connection and that it is sized for the maximum requirement of the unit.

4.2 AIO™ Wall Mounted and Wall Mounted Pro Gen 2 Units

1. Unscrew the Decorative Side Panel on the right side of the unit and set it aside.
2. Insert the male connector on the whip cord into the female connector on the unit's power terminal.
3. Reattach the decorative panel on the right side of the unit.
4. Connect the wires on the other end of the cable to the junction box.
 - Connect the brown and blue wires to the live phases.
 - Connect the yellow wire to ground.

4.3 AIO™ Wall Mounted and Wall Mounted Pro Gen 3 Units

1. Insert the male connector on the whip cord into the female power terminal located at the bottom-right corner of the rear of the unit.

Figure 4. Insert the male connector

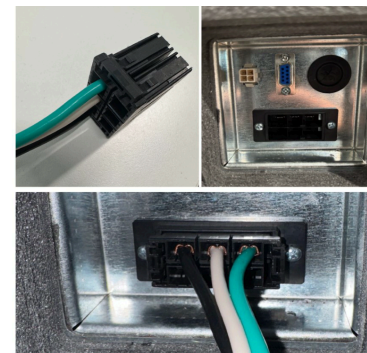


2. Connect the wires on the other end of the cable to the junction box.
 - Connect the brown and blue wires to the live phases.
 - Connect the yellow wire to ground.

4.4 AIO™ Vertical Stack

Figure 6. Cord detail

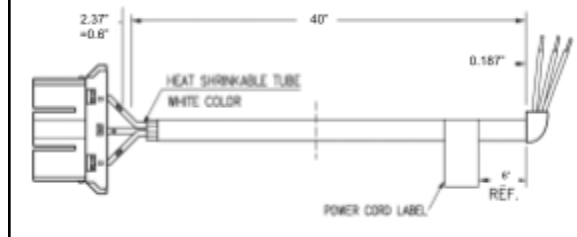


Figure 7. Cord detail

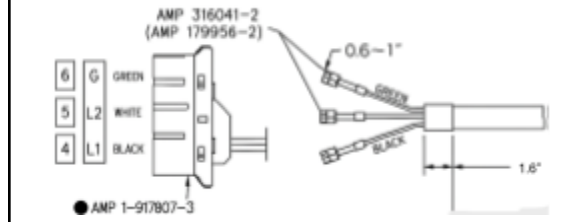
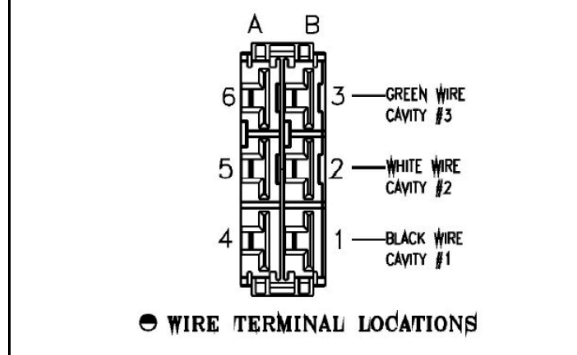


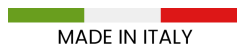
Figure 8. Wire terminal locations
